

Office of the Auditor General partners with ICPAK to promote accountability and good governance of the Ae

The Office of the Auditor General and the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya (ICPAK) agreed on a partnership on 18th July 2013 to promote accountability and transparency in the use of public resources, at a ceremony, at the Office of the Auditor General.

ICPAK Council members lead by the newly elected chairman, Mr. Benson Onkundi ; met the Auditor General, Mr. Edward Ouko, and had candid discussions on public resources utilization.

During the meeting the two institutions agreed to form a strong partnership to augment the capacity of OAG in light of the devolved government structure. The discussions also centred on the standardized reporting framework by National and County government, through use of accounting standards among other issues.

In this regard, the two institutions agreed to spearhead discussions on the way forward for the National Accounting Standards Board, Created under the Public Financial Management Act, 2012.
